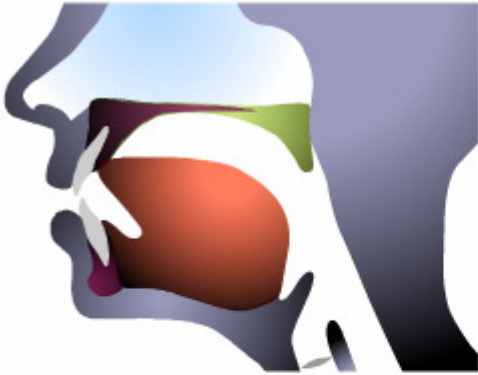


American 'T' Sound: The Silent 'T'



The Silent 'T'

If 'T' follows immediately after 'n', 'T' sound disappears. 'T' and 'N' are so close to the mouth that the 'T' can simply disappear.
