PARENT What's the plural of "child"?

CHILD The plural of "child" is "children".

CHILDREN

The plural of **child** is irregular. We say **1 child** but **2 children**.

Mr and Mrs Green are parents. Tom and Betty are their children.

WHO ARE MR AND MRS GREEN?

Mr and Mrs Green are the parents.

WHO ARE TOM AND BETTY?

Tom and Betty are the children.

ARE YOU A PARENT?

No, I'm not a parent, but I'm a child.

HOW MANY CHILDREN HAVE YOUR PARENTS GOT?

My parents have got ... children.

or My parents have got one child.

WHAT'S THE LAST LESSON ON TUESDAY?

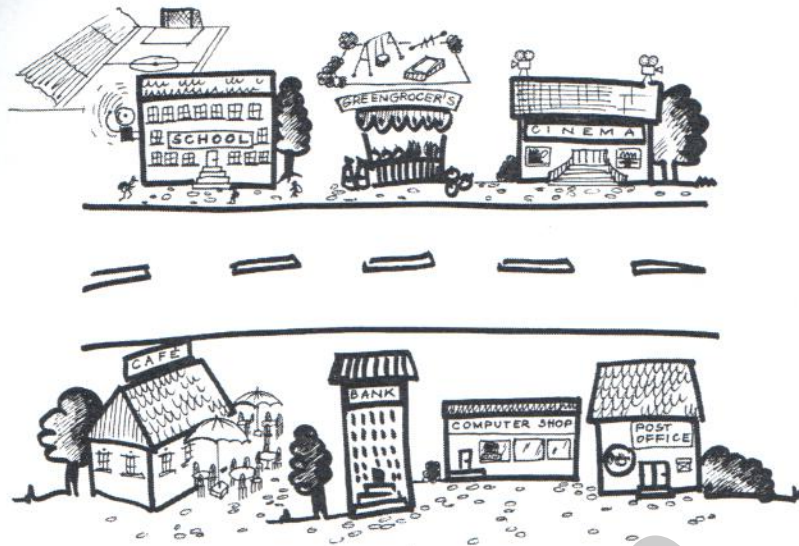
The last lesson on Tuesday is Computer Studies.

IS MATHS THE SECOND LESSON ON MONDAY?

No, Maths isn't the second lesson on Monday, but it's the third lesson on Monday.

**BUILDING
CONTRACTION**

This is a building and this is a building.
There are 7 buildings in this street.



HOW MANY BUILDINGS ARE THERE IN THE STREET?

There are 7 buildings in the street.

WHICH BUILDING IS BETWEEN THE BANK AND THE POST OFFICE?

The computer shop is between the bank and the post office.

WHICH BUILDING IS NEXT TO THE SCHOOL?

The greengrocer's is next to the school.

WHICH BUILDING IS OPPOSITE THE SCHOOL?

The café is opposite the school.

We use the word **contraction** instead of the words **short form**.

I HAVE NOT GOT	I HAVEN'T GOT
YOU HAVE NOT GOT	YOU HAVEN'T GOT
HE HAS NOT GOT	HE HASN'T GOT
SHE HAS NOT GOT	SHE HASN'T GOT
IT HAS NOT GOT	IT HASN'T GOT
WE HAVE NOT GOT	WE HAVEN'T GOT
YOU HAVE NOT GOT	YOU HAVEN'T GOT
THEY HAVE NOT GOT	THEY HAVEN'T GOT

The negative of the verb **have got** is **have not got**.
The contraction of **have not got** is **haven't got**.

The negative of **has got** is **has not got**.
The contraction of **has not got** is **hasn't got**.

WHAT'S THE NEGATIVE OF HAVE GOT?

The negative of *have got* is *have not got*.

WHAT'S THE CONTRACTION OF HAVE NOT GOT?

The contraction of *have not got* is *haven't got*.

WHAT'S THE NEGATIVE OF HAS GOT?

The negative of *has got* is *has not got*.

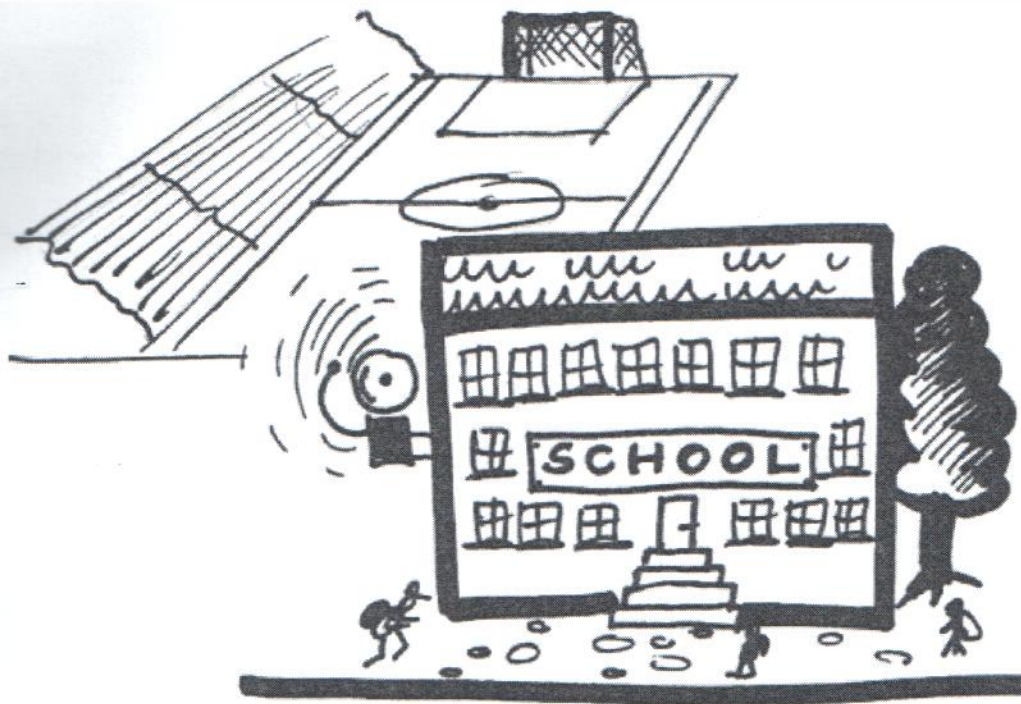
WHAT'S THE CONTRACTION OF HAS NOT GOT?

The contraction of *has not got* is *hasn't got*.
