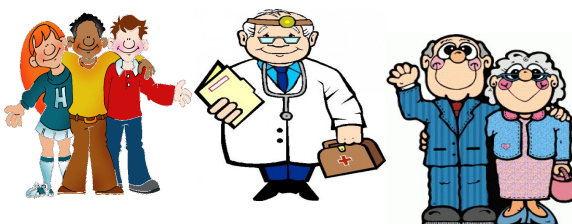




**At the end of the lesson, the student will be able to:**

No, **we** aren't.

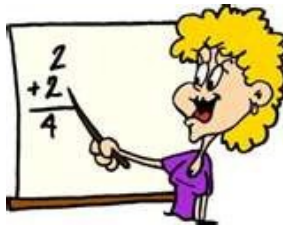
Are **they** teachers?
